

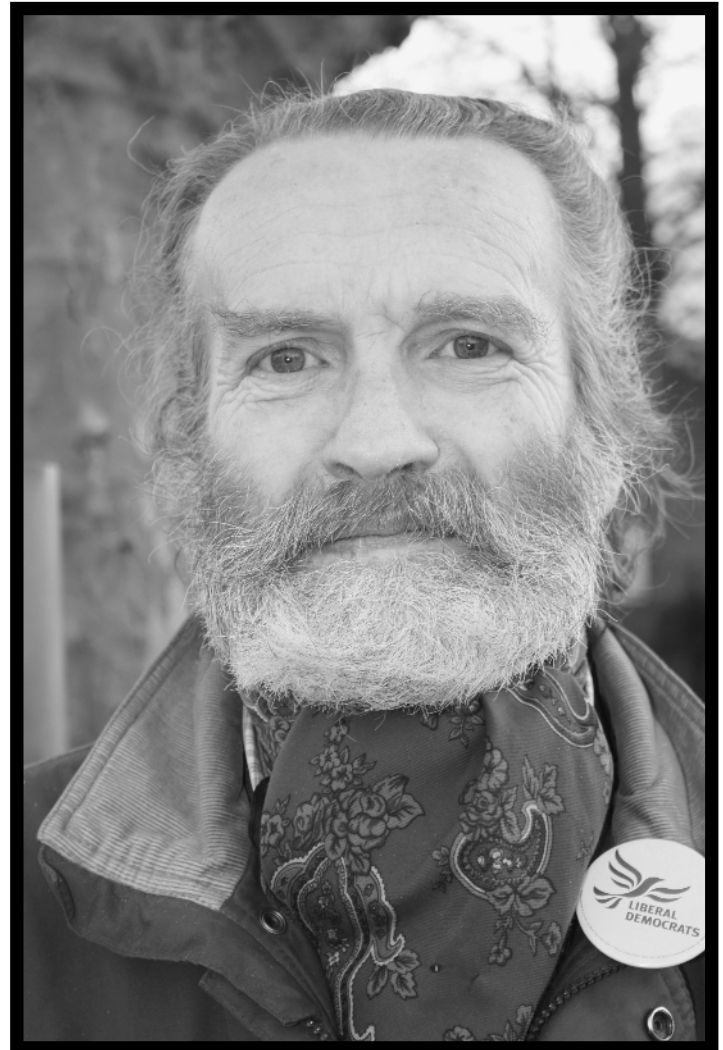


Neal Chubb

Planning News - Hainault Road/High Road



A developer lodged a second planning application for this landmark site at the junction of **Leyton High Road** and **Hainault Road**.

It was proposed to be erect a 3 - 5 storey building, with office use on the ground floor and 23 residential units, comprising 1 x 3 bedroom house, 3 x 4 bedroom houses and 19 flats (9 single units and 10 x 2 bed).

Lib Dem Cllr Bob Sullivan who was sitting on the Planning Committee is pleased to be able to report that planning permission was refused.

Focus Parking Survey (CPZ)

The Olympic Parking Zone from Lea Bridge Road to the Olympic Park ended on the 9th September. The Council has decided that residents of the roads which do not have a Council Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), having seen how a parking zone works, will now be consulted on whether they would like to have one.

The consultation documents are due out in **September** and have to be returned by **22nd October**.

Some residents are angry that the roads that have previously gone through a Council consultation on a CPZ are to have another one. **The Lib Dem Focus Team** is aware that in previous consultations many residents have queried the results.
